Dear Parent of Coach Pitch Player at 3&2:

We hope your season of baseball at 3&2 was enjoyable and that your child had a great time and learned more about baseball.

If your child started 1st grade this fall, the next stage at 3&2 is machine pitch. Machine pitch baseball is a fantastic transition from coach pitch to player pitch. The pitches are consistent and that means the players have confidence in not getting hit by the ball and are able to put the ball in play very often. With the ball in play, many defensive opportunities exist. Machine pitch baseball is a fast-paced, high-action game.

Machine pitch games will be played at our west complex at 8000 Monticello Road on fields designed specifically for 1st and 2nd graders. The 14-game season will start in mid to late April with games being played each day of the week. 3&2 will provide uniform shirts and hats, but equipment needs to be provided by the team.

Registration for the 1st grade machine pitch program will start in December and end in early February. Please watch for flyers that will be mailed in January.

An on-line manager's application is available on 3&2's web site under "Registration" if you are interested in managing a team.

Teams are formed based on where the players currently attend school or by what area they live in. As we move from T-ball through machine pitch years, (pre-school through 2nd grade), we want there to be free movement of players within a high school area to allow families to match up with managers who's style and personality match that of the what the families are looking for. Our rules state that teams are formed by public high school attendance area.
