Dear Parent of Machine Pitch Player at 3&2:

We hope your baseball season at 3&2 was enjoyable and that your child had a great time and learned more about baseball.

If your child started 3rd grade this fall, the next stage at 3&2 is player pitch. As was the case with machine pitch, player pitch games can be played any day of the week starting in mid to late April. The 14-game season will be played at both complexes. Starting in 3rd grade, teams will need to provide their own uniforms and equipment. Teams should obtain a sponsor(s) that will handle those costs.

Registration for the 3rd grade program will start in December and end in early February. Please watch for details in flyers that will be mailed in January.

An on-line manager's application is available on 3&2's web site under "Registration" if you are interested in managing a team.

Teams are formed based on where the players currently attend school or by what high school area they live in. Our rules state that teams are formed by public high school attendance area.

There will be several levels of play at the 3rd grade level next spring. Teams are seeded into these leagues based on how they did last year and if a team got stronger or weaker between seasons based on personnel. Pitching is a key determinant as well. Teams with pitchers who can throw strikes consistently will generally be placed higher than those teams that do not. 3&2's goal is to have each team win as many games as it loses. Stronger teams will play in the top league while lesser competitive teams will play in successively lower levels. Teams continue to bat through the roster and players are required to play a minimum of three innings defensively.

The 3rd grade season will culminate with the playoffs. Several teams from each league will have an opportunity to play in this season-ending tournament. Many other tournament opportunities exist at 3&2 during the summer as well. Not all teams take advantage of these opportunities.
